



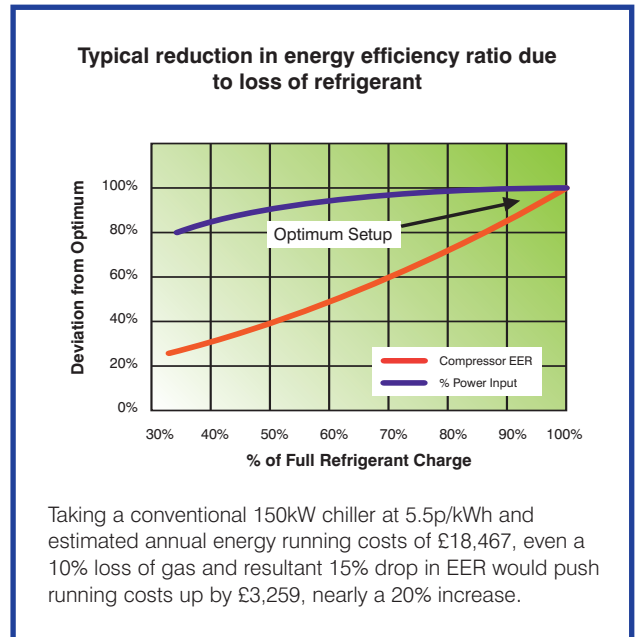

How has the F Gas Regulation come about?

F Gases are synthetic compounds and one of six 'greenhouse' gases that the EU has committed to reduce under the Kyoto Protocol. Ever since ozone-depleting CFCs and HCFCs were banned in the 1990s, HFCs, as used by Airedale, have not only been accepted globally as a safe and environmentally superior alternative but acknowledged as the best refrigerant for stationary air conditioning based on their technical performance and efficiency. HFCs do have a global warming potential, but only if they are not contained. The F Gas Regulation enforces this containment.
